## SCRIPTURE of the DAY

Proverbs 8: 22-31 Psalm 8: 4-9 Romans 5: 1-5 John 16: 12-15 Trinity Sunday answers the question, "What is the point of being a Christian?" **The whole point of Christianity is to point to God, who is the point of everything.** If we believe this, then to be Christian means living in accordance with that truth. Without this, then we can ask, what is the point if we miss this divine point?

As Peter says in the Acts of the Apostles, "In him we live and move and have our being" (Acts 17:28, RSV). This brings our understanding of God, who is immanent, the source of everything and in whom we find true meaning.

As Christians, we can come to some certainty about who God is. We pray and live in relationship with the Father, through the Son, in the Holy Spirit. For us, salvation means being drawn into God's own life. This is what the Church calls "deification," that is, the transformation of our lives so that we become like Christ. St. Peter expressed this saying, "He has granted to us his precious and very great promises, that through these you may become partakers of the divine nature" (2 Peter 1:4).

Our belief in the Trinity is not speculation. It is the result of God's self-revelation. God has shown himself to us throughout salvation history, from the call of Israel to the coming of Christ and the outpouring of the Spirit.

Yes, God is a mystery. But this should not discourage us but rather inspire us to go beyond the superficialities of our life into the presence of the infinite mystery we call God. This is not a cold idea, but a living relationship with the One who gives, and invites us to give ourselves in return.

Each time we say, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit," we stand in the truth of who God is, and who we are becoming.
